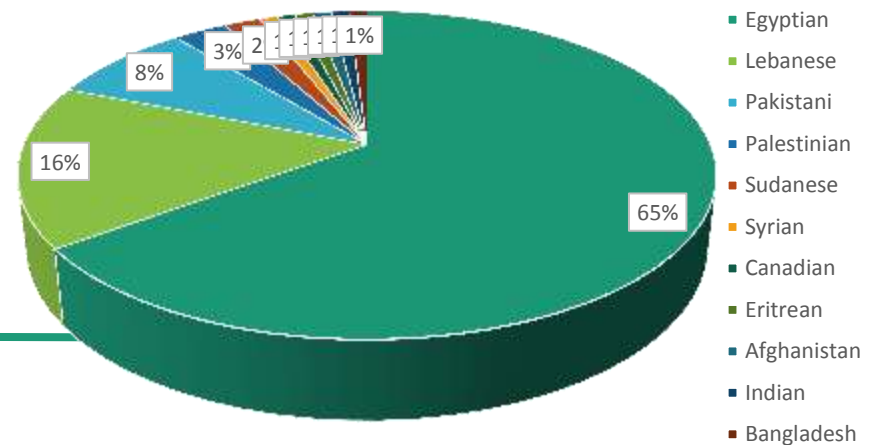

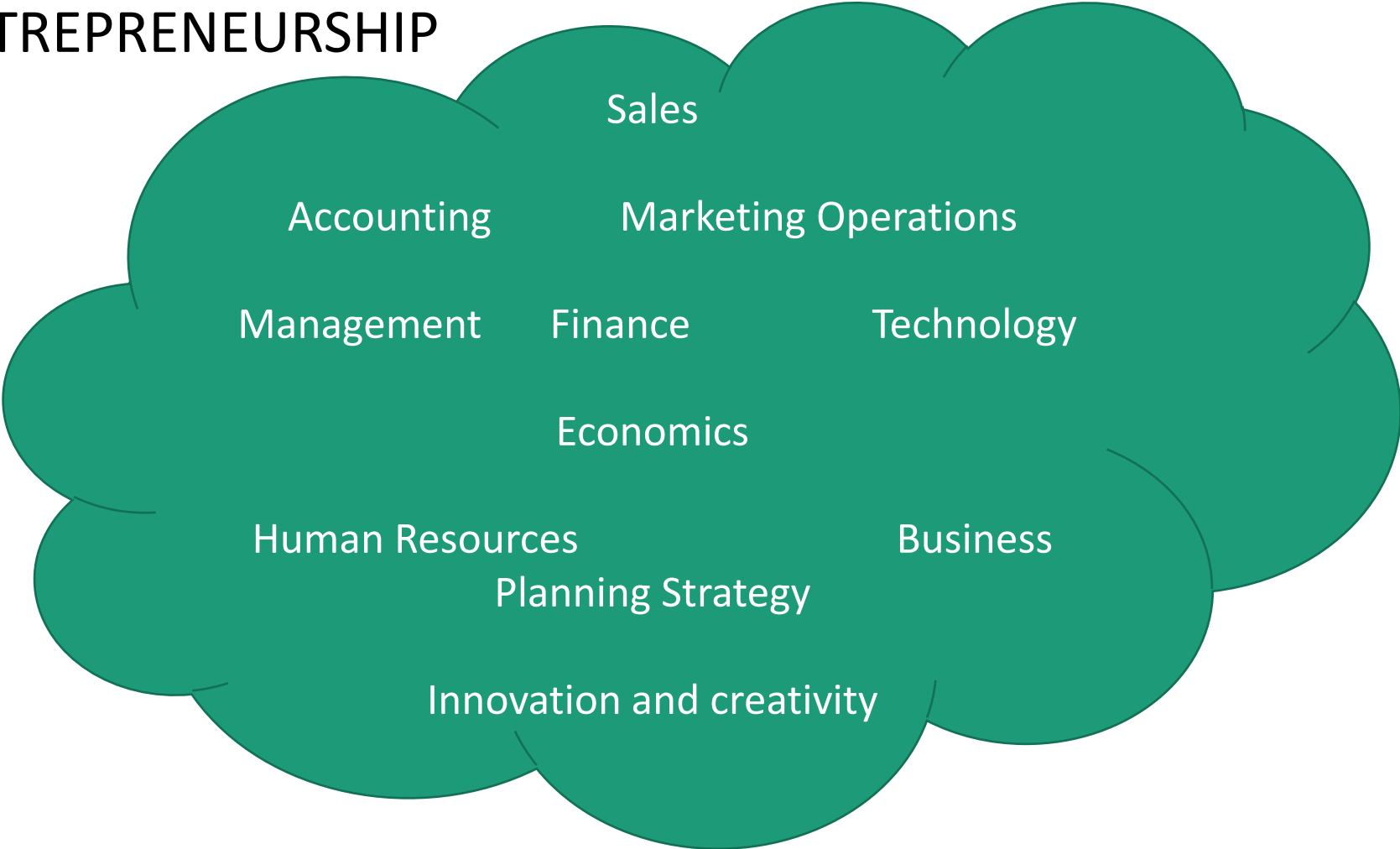


THE CITIZENS FOUNDATION

to over 100 underprivileged children each year

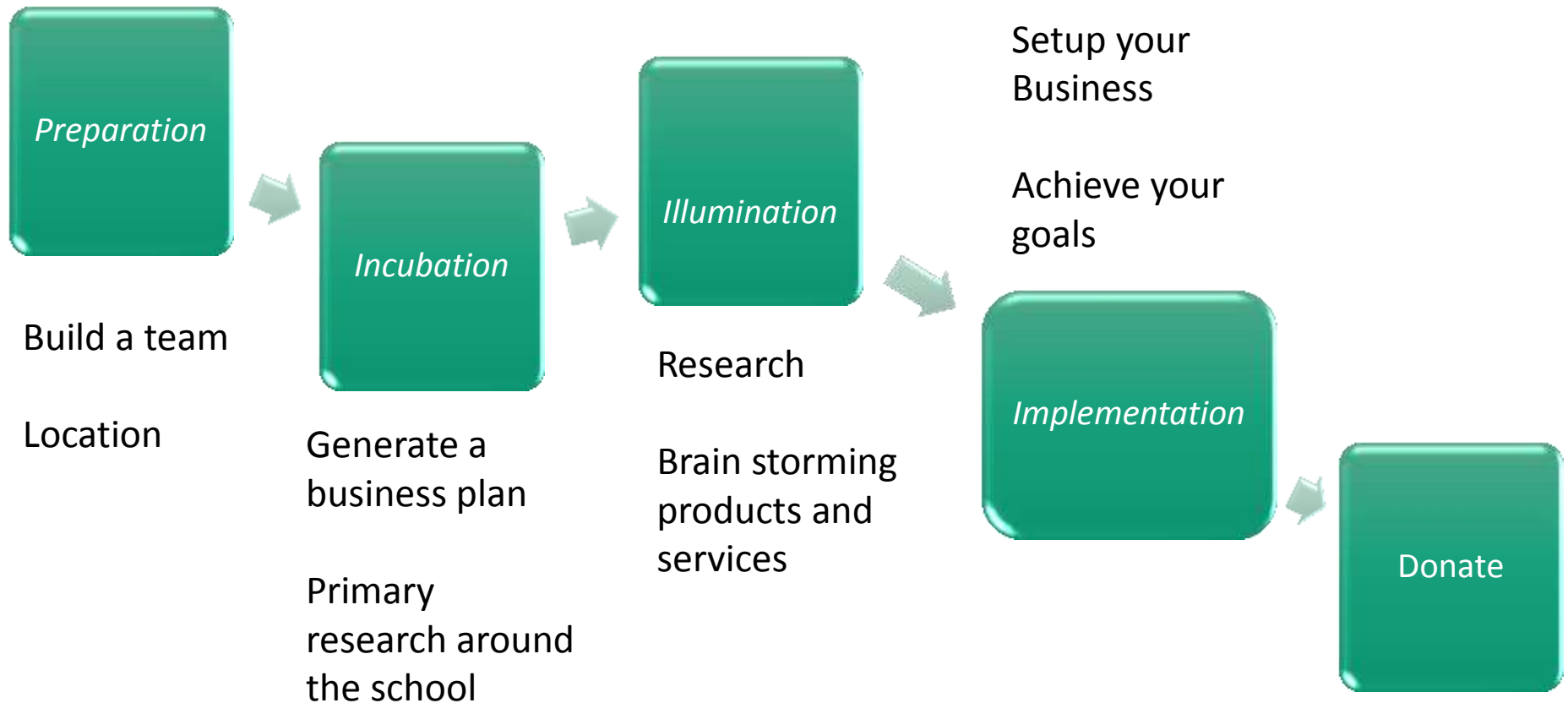
Why innovation is important when studying entrepreneurship?

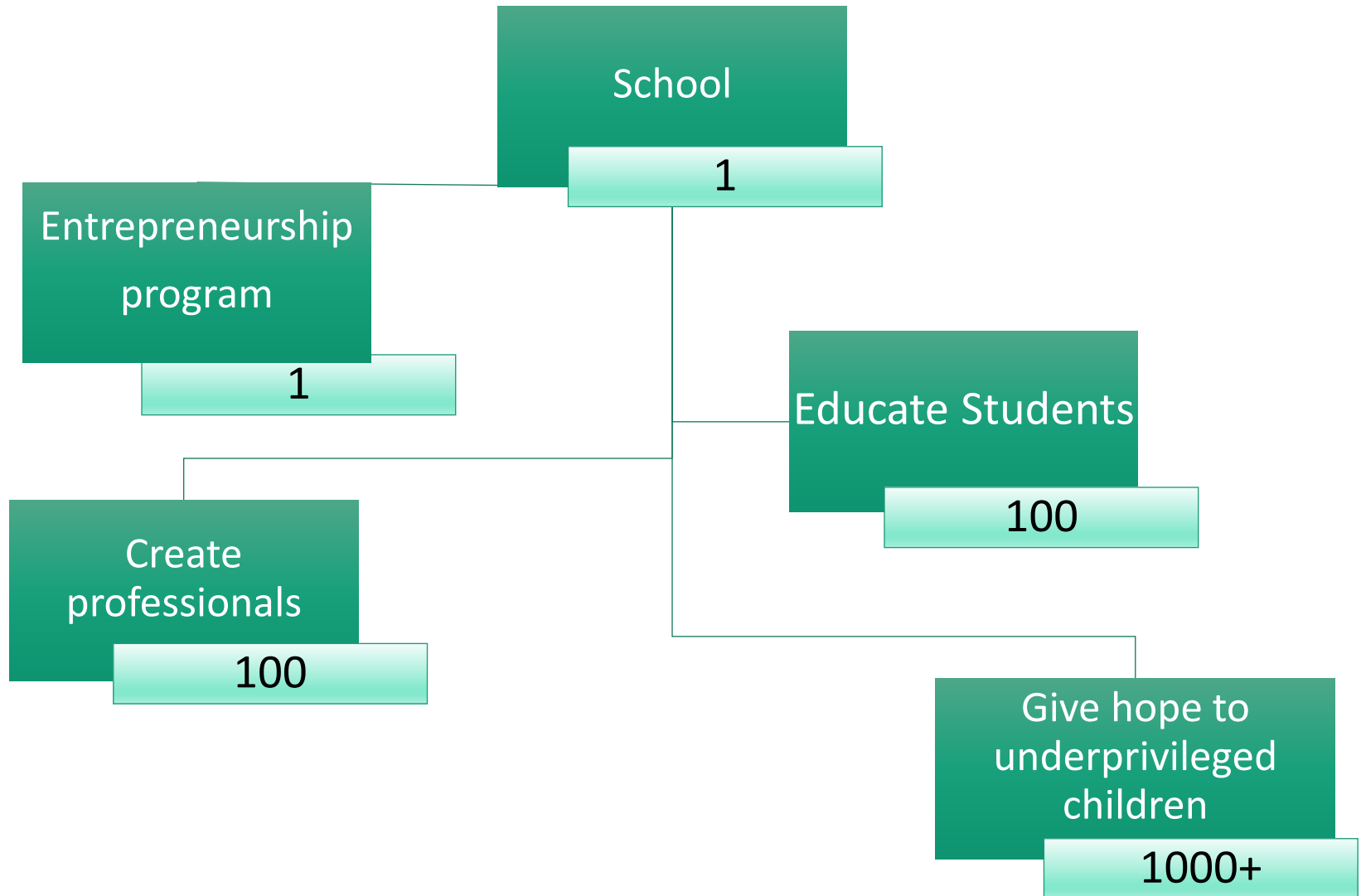

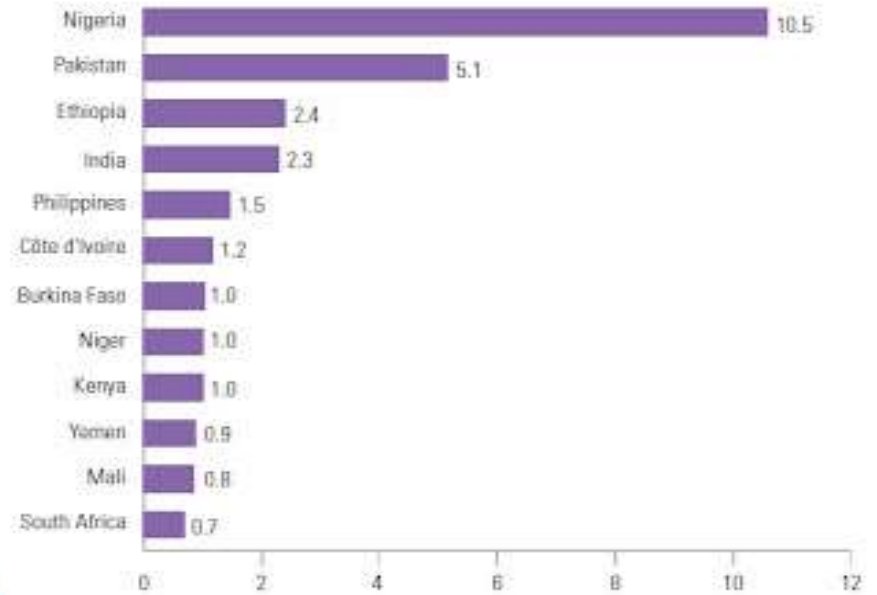
AIM

Number of children of primary school age who were out of school in 2010 or nearest year

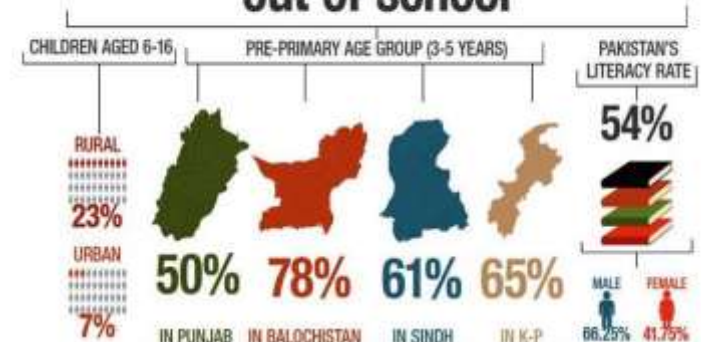
