“Project Based Learning: A New Initiative of NAMI in Nepal”

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INTRODUCTION TO NEPALESE EDUCATION SYSTEM

- Though Nepal is a developing country, Education is considered to be a sector which has had great improvement according to the data from the past decade.
- From 1971 to 2001, primary school numbers grew from 400,000 to 3.9 million, secondary school increased from 120,000 to 1.5 million and post – secondary level increased from 17,000 to 210,000.

CONTD.

- The literacy rates also experienced a whooping increase from 23% in 1981 to 54% in 2001. There has also been a rise in the number of different foreign universities and courses affiliations.
- The last official data, National Census 2011, puts Nepal's literacy rate at **65.9 %**. (Sep 1, 2014)

CONTD.

- Keeping our country in context, some of the private educational institutions have initiated technological advancement or any other significant advancement for the development of education system in Nepal.

NAMI!

- NAMI is also one of the best private educational organization which is providing education on the basis of 21st century education objectives.
- NAMI College initiated a new approach to educate students through project based learning.
- We thought of a project with the aim to help the society and have launched “Project Nyano”.

PROJECT NYANO

- Our students have started “Project Nyano” which focuses in teaching special vocational skills of making warm woollen clothes such as sweaters, gloves, scarfs, socks etc. during the free time.

CONTD.

- Till date, our students have been able to operate this project in ten different schools of Hilly and Himalayan region and about 1500 families are directly benefited from this project.
- Those children who learnt these vocational skills are able to make warm clothes during free time either for themselves or to sell it to other people in the community.
